RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Participants in the St. James Academy Horse Show agree and acknowledge that "By entering this competition, and signing the entry form, the exhibitor agree to be subject to the HHSA's rules, the prize list and the local rules of the competition.
- 2. This is a HHSA Pointed Show and is operated in accordance with the current rules of the HHSA.
- 3. An adult must sign all entry forms before a number is issued. A parent or guardian must sign junior rider's entries.
- 4. A signed blank check made out to St. James must be left with secretary before a # will be given out.
- 5. All stallions are barred from the show grounds.
- 6. Proper riding attire is required. All riders are required to wear ASTM approved protective headgear at all times while mounted.
- 7. The show management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes and to change rings if necessary in the best interest of the show.
- 8. All entries must have proof of a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of the show date.
- 9. All ponies must have a measurement card.
- 10. The decision of the judges will be final.
- 11. All dogs are barred from the show grounds.
- 12. A junior rider is a rider under 18 years of age as of December 1 of the previous year.
- 13. All entries will be judged on soundness upon entering the ring.
- 14. Cross entering is permitted where eligible. Please read class descriptions.
- 15. Three entries are required to fill a performance class. Two entries are required for a HHSA Medal Class.
- 16. Schooling will be permitted from 8:00-8:50 am. Ring restrictions may be imposed to insure exhibitor safety at the discretion of show management, and show stewards. Schooling prior to 8:00 is at own risk.
- 17. HHSA, St. James Academy, St. James Church, and the show management will assume no responsibility for any accident or injury which may occur to any horse, exhibitor, equipment, and/or vehicle.
- 18. EMT will be on the grounds at 8:00 AM, any schooling prior to this time is at own risk.
- 19. Classes will not be held for coaching conflicts.

DIRECTIONS

From 695 (Baltimore Beltway):

Take the Dulaney Valley Road (Exit 27B) North, Continue on Dulaney Valley Road crossing the Loch Raven Reservoir then bear left onto Jarrettsville Pike, Continue on Jarrettsville Pike for approximately 6.5 miles. Turn left onto Manor Road (4th traffic light after crossing the bridge). Continue on Manor Road for approximately 2 miles passing the Manor Tavern on the right. Manor Road changes to Monkton Road. You will see the St. James Church steeple on the hill to the right.

From I-83 (Jones Falls Expressway):

Travel north to Mount Carmel Road (Exit 27), Turn right at the stop sign onto Mount Carmel Road, Continue to the traffic light and turn right (south) onto York Road, Make an immediate left onto Monkton Road. The Hereford Methodist Church is on the corner. Continue for 7 miles on Monkton Road. After crossing the NCR trail (about 4 miles along) make a hard right to remain on Monkton Road. Continue on Monkton Road until you come to St. James Church and Academy on your left.

From Bel Air / Fallston:

Take Rt 152 (Mountain Road) toward Jarrettsville. Cross over Rt. 165 and continue on to Hess Road on the left. Make a left onto Hess Road. Continue to the traffic light. Cross over Jarrettsville Pike and continue on Hess Road to the stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign onto Monkton (Manor) Road. After passing the Manor Tavern, you will see the St. James Church steeple on the hill to the right.
