## Rules and Regulations

1. BCHSA is the primary association for the Caves farm competition and will uphold the 2022 BCHSA rulebook.
2. For horse show purposes, the age of an exhibitor will be considered as of December 1, 2021.
3. All exhibitors must appear in proper attire.
4. All riders cannot ride anywhere on the showgrounds without wearing protective headgear passing ASTM-SEI standards. Harnesses must be secured and if headgear has a brim, it must be flexible or semi-flexible. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until their headgear is properly in place.
5. Management reserves the right to change the location of any class, if necessary, and to cancel or combine any class, if entries so warrant.
6. NO person will be allowed in the ring during judging unless on official business.
7. The State of Maryland requires that all horses and ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within 12 months. **Please email the Coggins and vaccine certificate for each horse to the show secretary prior to the show date to reduce time in the office on the day of the show – [alschneid@comcast.net](mailto:alschneid@comcast.net).**
8. All ponies must have a current measurement card or be measured at the show.
9. All dogs must be leashed AT ALL TIMES.
10. No numbers will be issued without a signed blank check and signed entry form. Junior rider entries must be signed by an adult.
11. Three entries needed to fill a performance class. Pony Hunter will be split if there are 4 in each section.
12. The MHSA, HHS A and BCHSA and the show committee of Caves Farm will assume no responsibility, is not liable for any injury to person or to any horse at any time, which includes going to, coming from and in the ring. Neither will it be responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agent's properties on the show grounds.
13. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.
14. Class entry fee will be \$20.00 •• Office Fee - \$35. Exception – Medal and Classic classes will be \$25.00 per class. PRE-ENTRY DISCOUNT - \$10.00 if entry is received by 6 pm Thursday before the show.

## Points of Interest

1. Why are some divisions running twice? These divisions are not compatible across the three associations attending the show. There are various rules that each association has that make the divisions different enough that they need to be run separately (i. e., Long Stirrup Equitation has different age limits). Since BCHSA is the primary association, there are a few of those incompatible divisions that are not being offered a second time at these shows.
2. BCHSA Classic – The Low Children/Low Adult Amateur Hunter Classic, Children/Adult Hunter Classic, Thoroughbred Classic and Pony Hunter Classic will all be offered at this show. Please see BCHSA Rule Book for complete details and guidelines. Caves Farm will run the traditional divisions as open card jumping rounds and will keep a running numerical score from the first classic round (the second class of the division, denoted by an \* on the prize list). The top twelve scores from the first round will be called back to compete in the second Classic round.
3. Water and drag breaks will be scheduled and well announced throughout the day of the show, at the discretion of show management based upon weather and footing needs.
4. The unjudged warm-up will only be available for Ring One until the Schooling break.

**Directions to Caves Farm's Horse Trailer Entrance**  
11650 Park Heights Avenue, Owings Mills, MD 21117

**From 695 N:** Take Exit 21 – Stevenson Road, turn LEFT at the end of the ramp and then take the first RIGHT onto Brooks Robinson Road. Follow to the traffic light and turn RIGHT onto Park Heights Avenue. Continue 2 miles. Go straight through the stop sign at the 4-way stop of Caves Road and Park Heights Avenue and go ½ mile to entrance on LEFT at 11650 Park Heights Avenue.

**From 695 S:** Take Exit 21 – MD 129, Park Heights Avenue. Turn LEFT onto Park heights Avenue. Continue 2 miles. Go straight through the stop sign at the 4-way stop of Caves Road and Park Heights Avenue and go ½ mile to entrance on LEFT at 11650 Park Heights Avenue.

**From Westminster:** Take 140E, turn LEFT on MD 128N/Butler Road (Butler Road becomes Worthington Avenue which becomes Greenspring Avenue), turn RIGHT onto Garrison Forest Road, turn LEFT on Park Heights Avenue, entrance is on the RIGHT 1.2 miles past the 4-way stop for Park Heights and Walnut Avenue.

**Guidelines for Submitting Equine Vaccination Documentation**

The Health and Safety of all horses is top priority at Caves Farm show grounds. Please email your Equine Vaccination Record to the show secretary before the show – [alschneid@comcast.net](mailto:alschneid@comcast.net).

1. At Caves Farm, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the grounds. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturer's or veterinarian's recommendation. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner or agent with care, custody and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

**Entry Agreement**

I understand and agree that by entering this Competition, I am subject to Association Rules, the Prize List, and local rules of the competition.

**Assumption of Risk, Waiver and Indemnification** • This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition (Caves Farm Horse Show) to the following:

I AGREE that the "Competition" as used herein includes the Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm")

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Association and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Association or the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Association or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Association and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Association strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries.

If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching, and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the Association.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE to be bound by all applicable Association Rules and all terms and provisions of this entry blank and all terms and provisions of this Prize List.
